Let me introduce you to Conrad and Fiona Kwok, Canadian Baptist Ministries global field staff. Some readers of *Tidings Magazine* may remember them from their visit to the Atlantic Baptist Women's annual interMISSION conference a couple of years ago. Both Conrad and Fiona are dedicated to furthering the kingdom of God through their work in Asia and have been facing the frontlines through new developments in their ministry.

The Kwoks have been serving in Northern Thailand in an area called the Golden Triangle, where they have been supporting local church leaders and teaching at the Bethel Bible Institute. The Golden Triangle region includes Laos, Myanmar, and Thailand, and is an area infamously

known for the production of opium and heroin, and for high rates of drug addiction. In addition to this mission, Conrad and Fiona have recently been called to serve as the Chinese Ministries team leaders in Asia with Canadian Baptist Ministries. Working out of Thailand, the Kwoks will continue to help develop community programs and facilitate leadership training with their church partners throughout Asia, and they will also be heavily involved in encouraging and leading local partners and field staff in Asia. This is a huge undertaking, and the Kwoks, in faith, have risen to the challenge.

Conrad and Fiona have spent a lot of time travelling in Asia and in Toronto, Canada, over the last months. Several speaking and teaching opportunities have allowed them to develop relationships within the communities that they are working with in Asia, and, while visiting churches in Toronto, they had the opportunity to share their hearts for ministry. During November and December, the Kwoks welcomed two CBM SENT mission teams to join them in their work. These frontliners have their work cut out for them, and so I invite you to support them through prayer.
