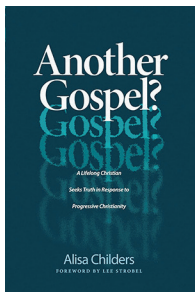

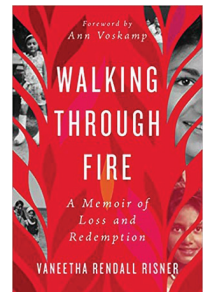
Another Gospel? by Alisa Childers

to be ready to give an answer to those who question the validity of orthodox Christianity.

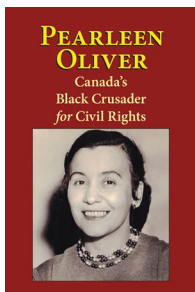
Walking through Fire, by Vaneetha Rendall Risner

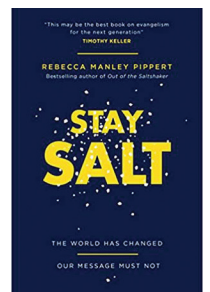
